

Dear font lover,

**Thank you so much for buying my font !**

**Here is a quick tutorial on how to install it, so that you could access to the extra features such as ligatures, alternate glyphs and underlinings.**

- 1 First, if you have installed a personal free version of the font on your system, uninstall and delete it, you don't need it anymore. Sometimes, you may need to restart your computer, keep this in mind ! ;)
- 2 If you're working with Adobe programs, and any other program who can deal with OpenType features, or at least display a glyph panel just install [hotel\\_de\\_paris.otf](#) and [hotel\\_de\\_paris\\_Xe.otf](#)
- 3 If you're working with another program less skilled with OpenType, you'll have to install all the TTF files : [hotel\\_de\\_paris.ttf](#) , [hotel\\_de\\_paris\\_Xe.ttf](#) and [hotel\\_de\\_paris\\_Ve.ttf](#)
- 4 In your program or software, simply type your word with Hôtel de Paris Xe. This is the plain and solid version of the font. Pick the color you want (I'll chose a yellow).

- 5 Then copy the layer with the font or the block with the font, at the exact same place. At this point, you shouldn't see anything changing. But now, let magic happens.
- 6 Select the word which is on top, and chose Hôtel de Paris . This is the striped version of the font. Change it's color (let's try with a grey). And...Shazam !

You can select the background word and move it a little.

Additionally, you can play with blend modes, there is always something cool to find. Be creative !

HÔTEL

You'll notice that the font is provided with a huge collection of little words.  
These little words are great to connect other words with elegance and balance.  
The few languages available are english, spanish, french and german.

Here is the complete list of these words :

Here's how to do this.









Type what you want in lowercase and when you want to use a little word, type it in uppercase... Shazam !

HÔTEL in lowercase      DE in uppercase      PARIS in lowercase

HÔTEL DE PARIS

If your program doesn't support OpenType feature, you'll need to use the 3<sup>rd</sup> downloaded file :  
[hotel\\_de\\_paris\\_Ve.ttf](#)

Each letter is related to a little word. Here is the character map, to help you.
